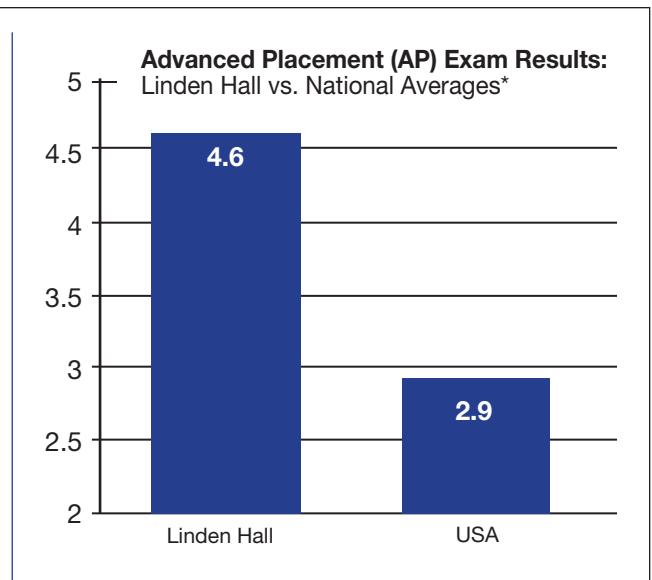
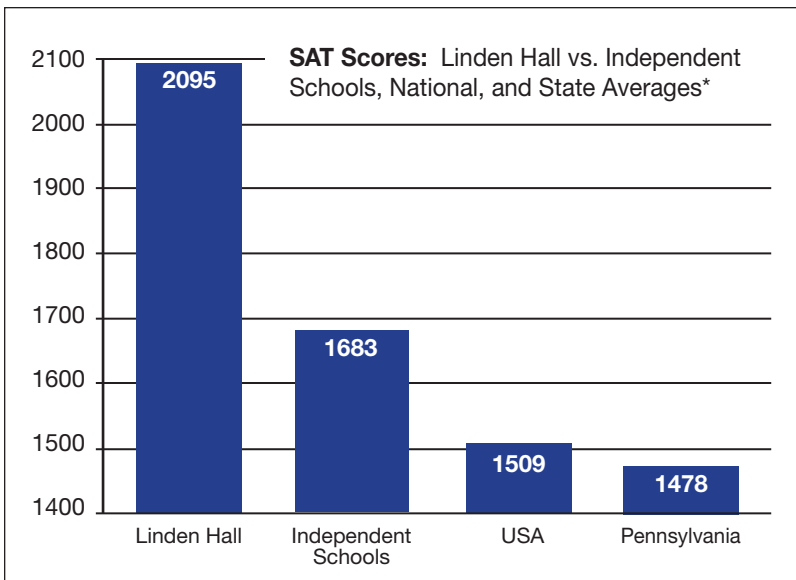

Location:

Linden Hall is located on Main Street in historic Lititz, Pennsylvania, a safe and charming town of 8,000 located off Route 501 between Harrisburg and Philadelphia.
