APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Complete all applicant and parent parts of the application form.
- Enclose with the completed application form a check for the non-refundable application fee in the amount of \$45, payable to Linden Hall. *(For students living outside the U.S., the non-refundable application fee is \$100.)*
- Mail completed parent and applicant information forms to Linden Hall's Admission Office.
- Give the **two recommendation forms and the transcript form** to the appropriate persons at your daughter's current school.
- Schedule an interview with the Admission Office. Interviews are required for all students living in the United States. Please call 800-258-5778.
- Provide SSAT scores.

Note: Linden Hall is a test center. Please contact us for scheduled test dates and times.

CAMPUS VISIT

- Please call to arrange an appointment for a visit and tour of the campus.** Appointments may be made for 9 a.m., 10 a.m., or 1 p.m., Monday through Friday. Plan to spend at least two hours at the school on the day of your visit. There will be opportunities to visit classes and to speak with the Director of Admission and other staff members. We usually have a current student tour with the applicant and a staff member tour with the adults in the family. The student may be asked to complete a short writing sample during the visit. Students living outside the United States may be interviewed by telephone or video conferencing.

TEACHER RECOMMENDATION AND TRANSCRIPT REQUEST FORMS

- Teacher recommendation forms found in this booklet should be given to your daughter's current English and math teachers to be completed and returned to Linden Hall by the teacher. The **transcript form** must be signed, given to the Office of Academic Records of your daughter's current school, and sent by that office to Linden Hall, along with the requested materials. All standardized testing results are required.

FINANCIAL AID

MAKING A LINDEN HALL EDUCATION AFFORDABLE

Linden Hall is committed to providing a quality education to all students. If possible, we aim to make a Linden Hall education affordable for all accepted students. To that end, we offer need-based financial aid to students and their families.

The Linden Hall Financial Aid Committee considers the financial aid requests of re-enrolled students first. New students are considered after these awards have been made. A limited budget dictates a "first come, first served" process. Early applications are encouraged.

Parents or guardians requesting financial aid must make application to both Linden Hall and the Scholarship Service of Princeton, New Jersey. The Linden Hall Financial Aid Committee considers all information and determines grants.

There are several low-interest bank loans available for the independent school student offered through Citibank, Bank of America, and New Educational Resources.

Linden Hall also offers a tuition payment plan that extends the tuition cost over several months if you wish.

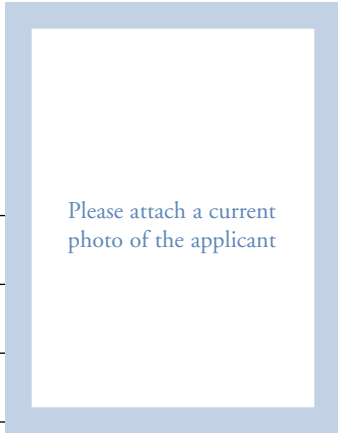
