Two Smartboard installations. The two Smartboards that were installed last December are a huge hit and one of the greatest tools ever for teachers to communicate difficult subjects involving mathematics visualization. Our two newest boards will serve for both the Physics and Chemistry classes.	\$5,500
New lab benches and stools in the two science rooms	\$7,000
A school-wide broadcast system (Scala - also including the computers).
