Formal Verb Conjugations

Tense marker begins the sentence and applies to successive sentences until there is a change. Dialog tends to include the tense marker with each sentence while formal writings and decrees tend to use one tense marker for all sentences in the same tense until there is a change.

recal.....past tense marker, formal
cal.....present tense marker, formal
rocal.....future tense marker, formal

Sentences use passive voice.
social equals: pronoun r'(ra')+root
very formal: title r'(ra')+root
