UPPER SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST 2022-2023

Because many faculty members request specific supplies for Upper School students, we do not create a comprehensive supply list for the Upper School. Students can expect to receive information about specific supplies needed for their classes directly from teachers. As we begin the school year, students and families can expect teachers to be flexible at the start of the year as specific supplies are acquired.

However, there are certain supplies that every Upper School student will need:

- First, be sure to consult our online bookseller MBS Direct (now a part of the Barnes and Noble family; https://bnck-12.com/lindenhall) once class schedules are released, for information about required textbooks. Read the book list carefully. There are several classes this year for which textbooks are either optional or students may select between a print or an electronic edition of the same textbook to use in class.
- Secondly, every student will need a computer. Please see the technology department guidelines on our website for specific recommendations for our bring your own device program. (www.lindenhall.org/academics/bring-your-own-device-program)
- Thirdly, every student will need a **calculator**. We recommend the Texas Instruments calculator brand. This year our math department recommends:
 - For Algebra 1 and Geometry classes, the TI-30XIIS calculator is recommended, though students can use any calculator in the TI-30-series. Non-graphing calculators best support skill development at this level.
 - For Algebra 2 classes and beyond, please acquire a TI-84 Plus CE graphing calculator.
- Finally, there are some basic school supplies that you can purchase with your family before school begins. You can be certain that you will need loose-leaf notebook paper or spiral-bound notebooks, depending on how you prefer to organize your notes. You will need three-ring binders and dividers. You will also need pens, pencils, and other writing or drawing tools.
 - Additionally, every Upper School student should carry with her one or more personal dry-erase markers that she does not share with others. You may choose your own color(s)!
- Also note that all Upper School science students will use a spiral-bound duplicate lab book. You may use notebooks for multiple years, if there is still adequate space available. New lab books will be issued to new students or to students requesting a new book in class during quarter 1; student accounts will be charged for new books. Do not purchase this item on your own.
